Conference Call for Papers

The first 'Global Pan-African Conference: The Africa We Want,' organised by Mboka Festival of Arts Culture and Sport, will take place from Monday, 25 May, to Thursday 28 May 2020 in The Gambia. The 2020 conference commemorates the 120th anniversary of the first Pan African Conference, organised by Henry Sylvester Williams in London. Subsequent GPAC conferences will take place on alternate years. The UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) will be used as reference material as it is a partner in sustainable development. The first conference will focus on issues of governance, women, arts and culture, youth and diaspora.
